



## Pre-School Prices 2009

### Seasonal admission price for children or organised groups of any age:

### Educational Activities (designed for groups of max. 30)

<b>Meet a Tortoise</b> 10-minute session including animal feed and talk from a Wildwood tutor. Children may touch the tortoise (shell only) but there is strictly no feeding by visitors.	<b>£15</b>
<b>Meet a Deer</b> 10-minute session including animal feed and talk from a Wildwood tutor. Children will see the deer being fed (sorry, no visitor feeding) but there is no opportunity to touch the deer.	<b>£15</b>
<b>Meet an Owl</b> 10-minute session including talk from a Wildwood tutor. Children will see the owl up close but there will be no opportunity to touch the owl. Owls feed at night and so this session does not include seeing the owl being fed.	<b>£15</b>

### Adults accompanying schools/groups

<u>Category 1</u> Adults accompanying groups undertaking educational activities as listed above	<b>FREE</b> on the adult:child ratio shown; additional adults to pay the seasonal group admission charge	1:4
<u>Category 2</u> Adults accompanying groups conducting visits independent of the education department	<b>ALL</b> adults pay the seasonal group admission charge; no free places	n/a

## **Deposit**

We request a £30 deposit, payable in advance, from all schools and groups. Unfortunately, this deposit is non-refundable if you cancel within 28 days of your booking as we may have already turned away another group for your chosen date.

## **Booking Activities**

Please note that if you book activities with a Wildwood tutor, we will arrange for a tutor to work with your school and run those activities for you. If you decide on the day not to attend your activities, we are in the position of still having to pay your tutor for their time. Therefore, if you change your mind about the activities you have booked you must let us know by the day beforehand at the latest, otherwise you will still be charged for your activities. You will also be charged admission for **all** adults, as the free adults arrangement only applies if you both book **and** attend activities.

## **Payment**

- You can pay in one of two ways:
  - We can invoice you afterwards, or
  - Payment on the day in cash or by cheque (cheques payable to Wildwood Trust)
- If you prefer to be invoiced, please bring with you a sheet of headed notepaper with your contact details and the name of the person/department to which the invoice should be addressed.
- Please ensure you know how many children and adults you have in your group on the day for the invoice; give the numbers to admissions on arrival.
