- Must Book** Limited space events that must be booked in advance.
- Free Event** Events that do not attract any additional fee except for usual membership or admission into the park.
- Drop In** These events do not need to be booked in advance and can be attended at any time during the advertised session so long as space allows.
- CONSERVATION** These events are run by the Wildwood conservation team, and need to be booked directly. Conservation courses and events do not attract park entry fees.

Important information

- All events must be paid for at the time of booking and are non refundable (except when cancelled by Wildwood).
 - Access to all events is only permitted if membership or entrance fees have been paid. Courses, night tours, photo days, keeper and bushcraft experiences do not attract park entry fees.
 - All under 18's MUST be accompanied by an adult.
