Oak trees have thick trunks, rough bark and leaves like the picture. Can you see any?

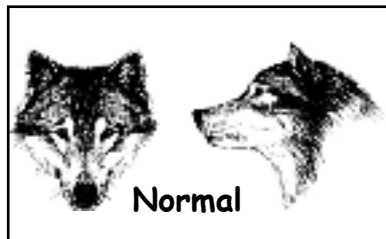
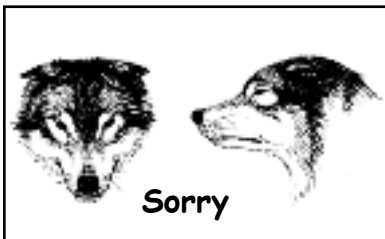
Look at the ground underneath the tree. How many things can you find that fell out of the tree?
